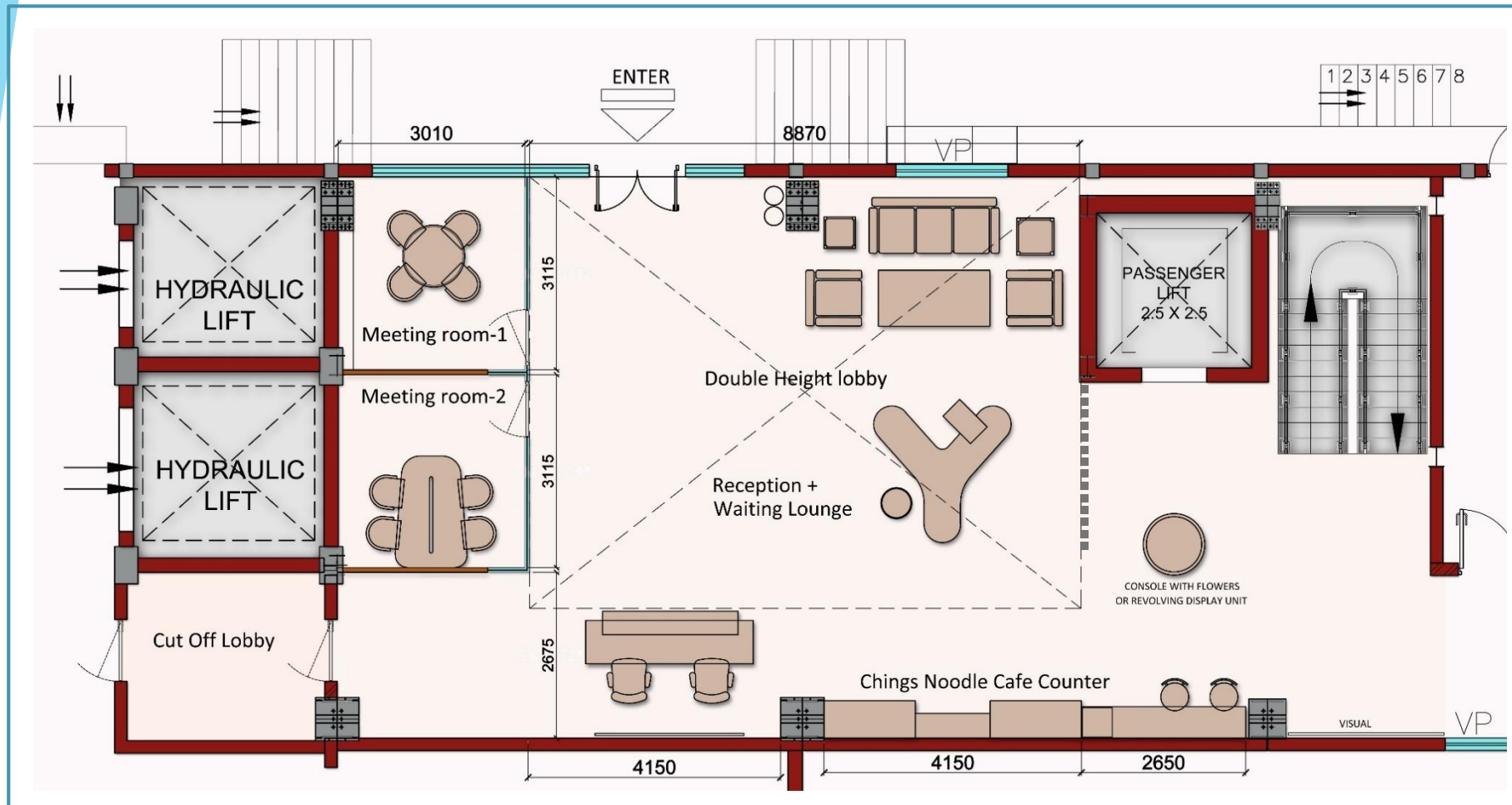

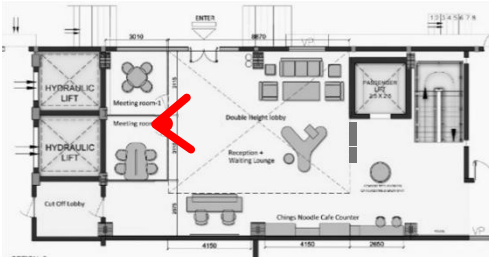

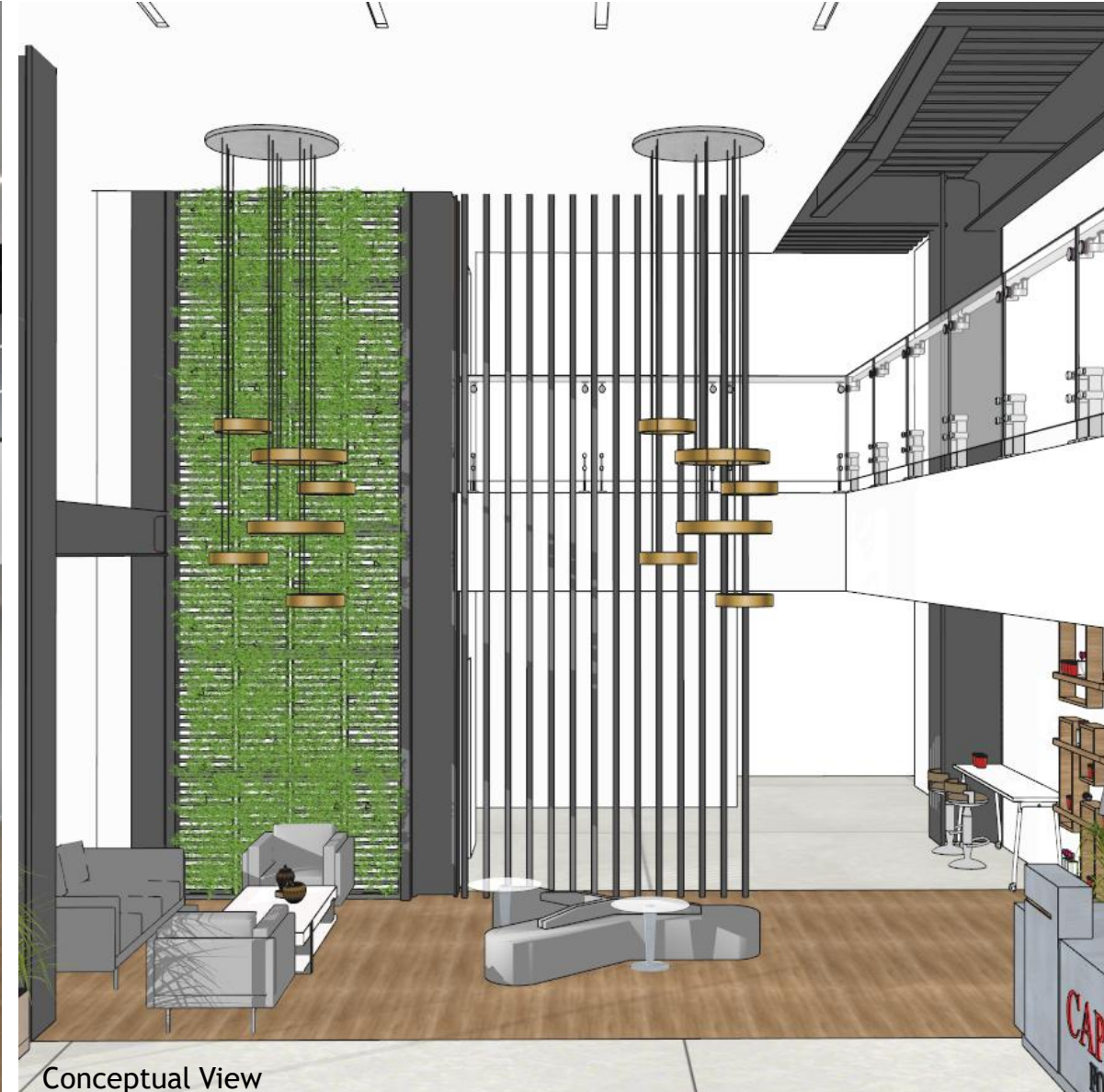

A formal setting will be adopted in terms of the color palate and finishes. With **complete false ceiling**, a **modern clean outlook** will be adopted for the reception area. Color will be added through a vertical **Green Wall** to add freshness to the ambience.

Statement Furniture

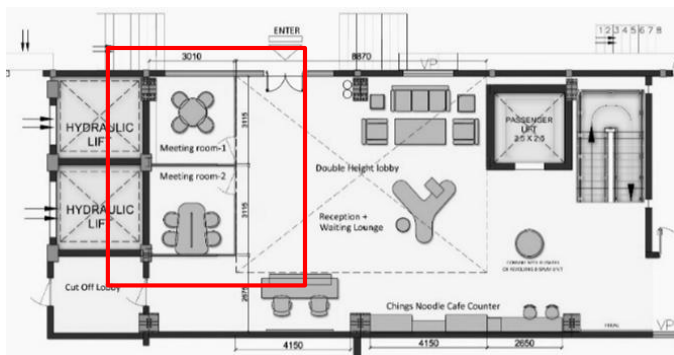
An **organic shaped informal seating** will be placed as a **statement piece** in the waiting area with a neutral palate depending upon the surroundings along with a formal set of seating.

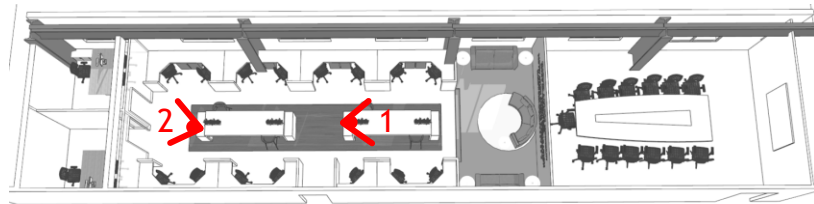

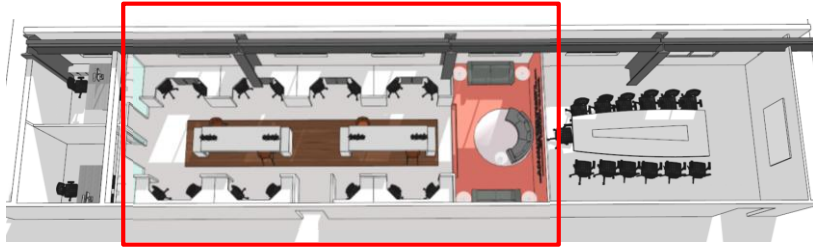
A completely **formal outlook** will be adopted for the administration area using a **formal color palate** as shown. Use of **clear glass** partition will reduce the heaviness of the color and provide transparency between the cabins and the workstation areas.

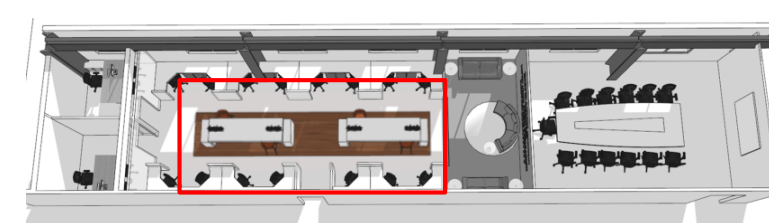
For the workstation area the color palate has been kept formal. **Wooden texture** has been used in combination to the **neutral grey hues**. **Linear lights** can be used forming a **pattern to add drama** to the space. The furniture will be kept in neutral tones of wood and grey. The ceiling will be kept **exposed with structure and services in grey** and **wooden textured ceiling** in cabins.

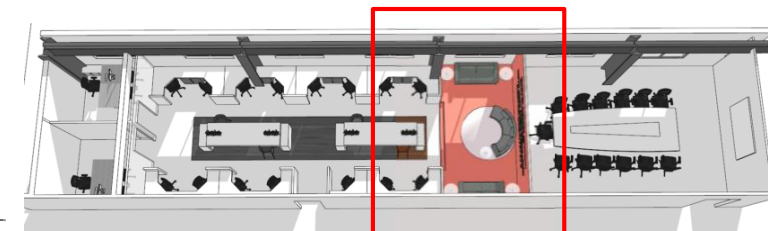

In this option the lounge area will be given a **bright vibrant color scheme**. The wall will be **decorated with an artwork** created with **words essential in the efficient working** of an office.

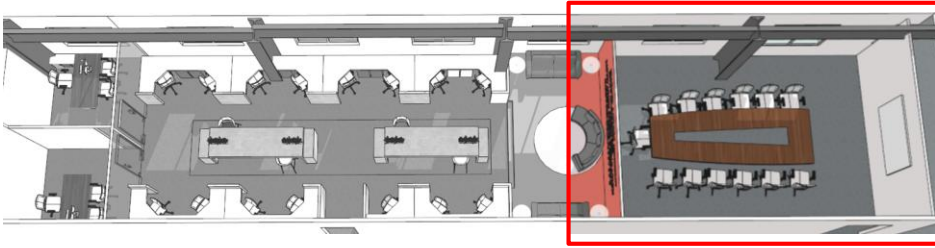

Admin office- Board Room



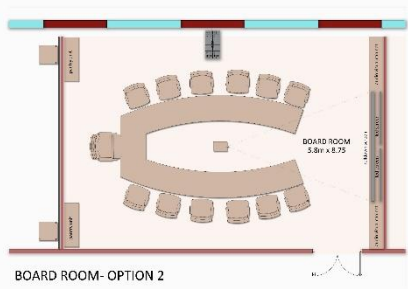
In this option the board room will have a **formal outlook**. Use of **wooden louvers** will be done in the ceiling to add warmth to the space.. The wooden texture will be balanced with the use of a **neutral color palate**. **Subtle, contemporary rectangular conference table** will add the required formal touch to the board room.

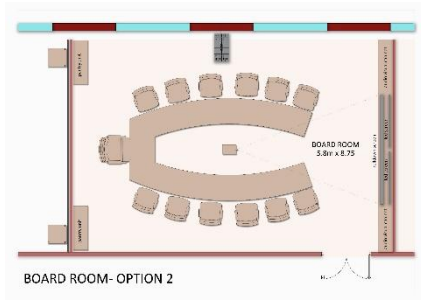

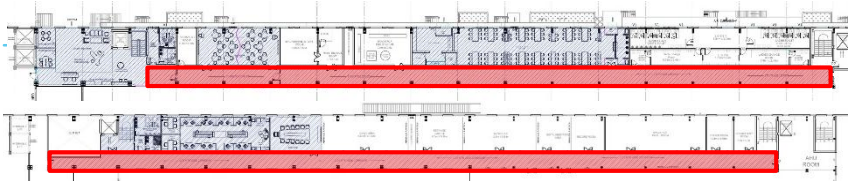

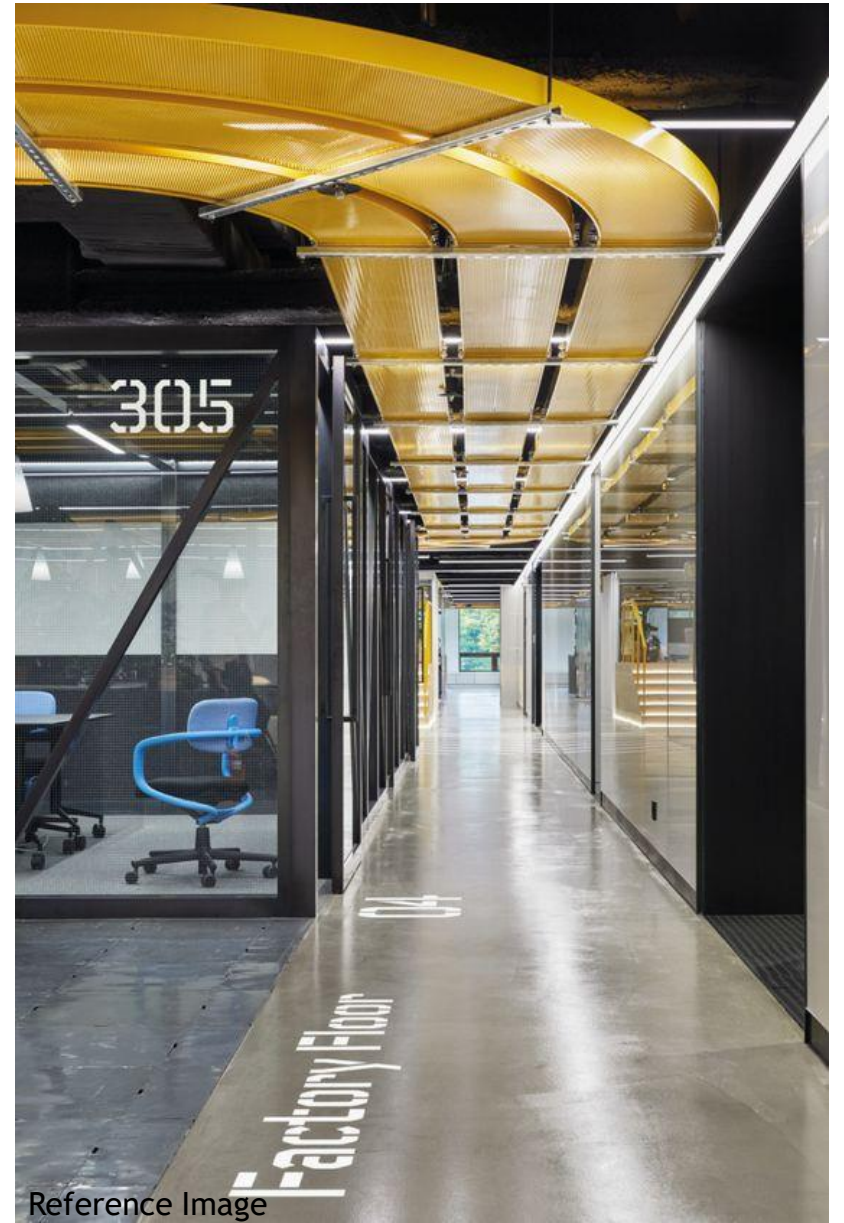
